Minimum GPA requirement 2.00 on a 4.00 scale.

A language proficiency score scale is required for non-native English or French speakers.

- Minimum requirement for students in English programs:
B2, TOEFL ITP 550, TOEFL IBT 80, TOEIC 700, IELTS 6, BULATS 70, Cambridge 170
- Minimum requirement for students in French programs:
B2 DELF or equivalent

- Submit all required documents by email
- ESC Amiens screens your application - screening process takes approximately 1 month after the application deadline
- Receive screening results from ESC Amiens by email

Exchange Program:

Exchange Students are exempt from paying a contribution to tuition fees, handling fees, student association fees or the breakage security deposit to ESC Amiens. Their tuition fees are paid to their own university.

³ All international students outside of Europe must register for a French Social Security number to assure coverage of your health care expenses at etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/. Registration is mandatory and free of charge and will entitle you to reimbursement of your health care expenses. To be reimbursed for your health care expenses at the highest possible rate, you can take out supplementary health care coverage or coverage from a mutual fund ("mutuelle"). Erasmus+ students benefit from their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).
