Institution

UC Leuven-Limburg is the second-largest university of applied sciences in Belgium with close to 15,000 students and 2,000 faculty. The institution has 9 different campuses spread out between the cities of Leuven and Hasselt (Limburg). UC Leuven-Limburg focuses on hands-on education and applied research in five fields of study of which management is one.

Academic information

Nomination and application

The following deadlines apply for both nomination and application:

- Autumn semester or full year: 15 June 2019
- Spring semester: 15 November 2019

Nominations are sent to incoming.man.limburg@ucll.be. All nomination e-mails must mention the nominees' full name, gender, field of study, period of stay (autumn/spring semester or full year) and e-mail address.

Academic calendar

At UC Leuven-Limburg, the academic year consists of two semesters:

1. Autumn semester: 21 September 2020 to 29 January 2021
2. Spring semester: 8 February 2021 to 2 July 2021

After 12 to 13 weeks of classes students participate in a 3-week examination period.

The typical study load for one semester is 30 ECTS.

Orientation days

All exchange students are expected to participate in the orientation days which are held in the week prior to the official start of classes. Participation is free of charge and includes one lunch and several activities.

Course registration

Online course registration is not available. Registration will be done by the International Relations Office at the orientation days, provided the student's learning agreement (selection of courses) has been approved by the home institution and UC Leuven-Limburg.

Language requirements

Exchange students must have a B1 level in English to follow courses in English and a B2 level in Dutch to follow courses in Dutch. For foreign language courses, specific language requirements may apply.

Grading system

The grading scale ranges from 0 (very poor) to 20 (excellent), 10 being the minimum pass mark.

Cost of living

A student room in Hasselt costs at least 270 euros per month. Students should expect to spend a minimum of 60 euros per week on food and 25 euros per year on a bus pass or a rental bike (including security deposit). The total monthly living cost is estimated at 650 euros. Further, exchange students are expected to take out health insurance coverage for Belgium prior to their arrival.
